The World's Largest Truck Convoy® is a national one-day celebration of the trucking industry, its allied partners and law enforcement all working together to help raise money for Special Olympics.

Wisconsin's law enforcement officers will escort the Convoy from the Pioneer Travel Plaza in Richfield (exit #60) and travel north on Highway 41 to Oshkosh (exit #113).

Special Olympics athletes and families, community organizations, companies and law enforcement agencies will welcome the truckers as they enter the EAA Grounds for lunch with music and awards.

The celebration is held to recognize participating truckers and the support they give to Special Olympics. In 2010, a total of 120 trucks participated and raised more than \$83,000 for the 10,000 athletes of Special Olympics Wisconsin. Since 2005, Wisconsin's Convoy has raised more than \$450,000 with a total of 697 trucks.

## TYPES OF TRUCKS ALLOWED IN THE CONVOY:

Trucks welcome in the Convoy include semi-trucks, truck/trailer combinations, fire trucks, dump trucks, flat beds, buses, large tow trucks, large box trucks, etc.

All trucks must be 10,000 lb GVW or larger.  
*Hazardous materials (bobtail OK) or trucks with alcohol/tobacco names or logos are not permitted.*
